Biography

Fabian Bonke advises clients in disputes arising from complex infrastructure, energy and technology projects. Fabian has advised in a great number of project disputes, in particular related to offshore wind farms, energy-from waste plants, water treatment plants and oil & gas projects, tunnels and roads, as well as rail vehicle construction. His focus is on Europe and the Middle East. He has gained particular expertise in EPC, O&M contracts and FIDIC Conditions of Contracts. He advises on disputes in the technology sector, for example in software and IT outsourcing projects. He has in-depth knowledge in the processing of extensive amounts of data using software solutions (e.g. claim management and e-discovery tools).

From an early stage in his legal career, Fabian set a strong international focus. In parallel to his German legal studies, he also studied French law at the Saarland University and earned a French law degree. Additionally, he spent one year at the University of Geneva. During his legal traineeship, he clerked for judges at the Regional Court of Mainz and was employed at leading law firms in Frankfurt and New York. After having been admitted to the bar, Fabian
