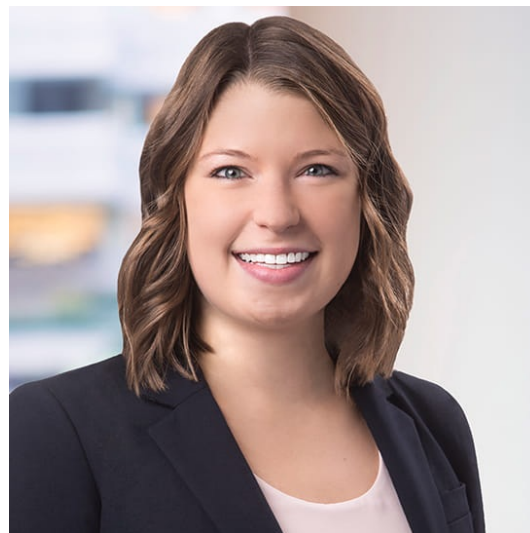
As a regulatory associate, Cayla Ebert advocates for her clients to accomplish client-oriented solutions to complex, international challenges.
