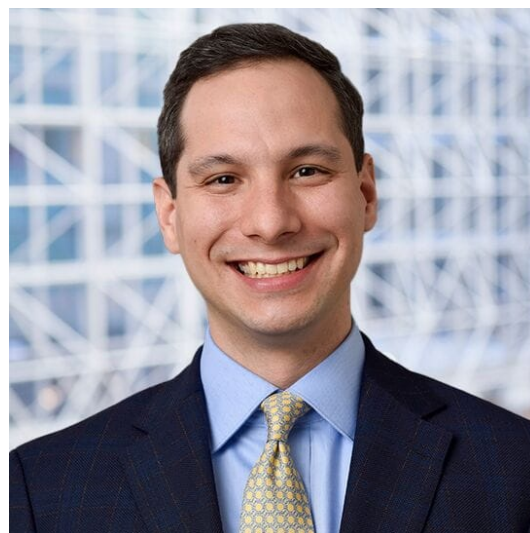
Biography
