### Biography

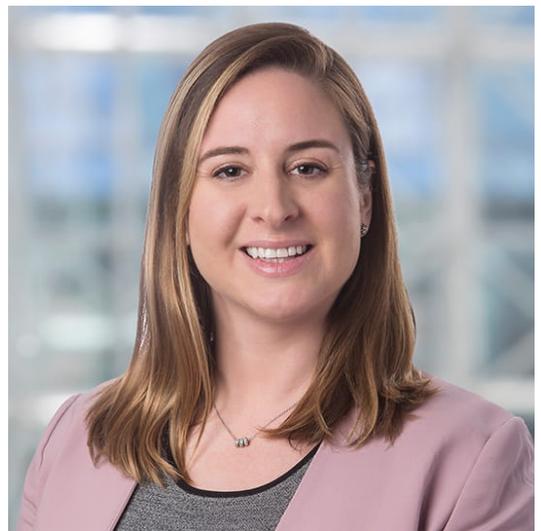
